

INTERSCHOLASTIC WON BY CHICAGO

**Victors Nearly Double Points
Won By Second Place
Teams**

Ann Arbor, Mich., May 24.—Chicago University High outdistanced the field in Michigan interscholastic meet Saturday on Perry Field, picking up 48 points to 14 for Kalamazoo and Cass City who were tied for second.

As a result of the victory the Chicago school took approximately the same amount of points as the school winning it three times, and the Hudson Iron, cop for winner the half-mile relay race.

A Jones, of University High School, was also individual point winner with 15 points. He was both hurdler, second in the broad jump, and third in the 100-yard dash. He scored on the day in five other winning relay teams.

While Lafayette Buffalo gave the best individual performance of the day by breaking the meet mark in the mile, Tam led who in earlier two-mile skampan, made the mile in 4:24.5, four seconds faster than the mark made in 1916 by Harold of Toledo school. Helms is training for the Olympic triathlon.

Miller, of West Waterloo, Iowa, won both 2000 yard, 4000 yard, and 8000 yard, although Jones, of Detroit Central, pushed him five yards in the 2000. This boy is said to be one of the best high-school athletes seen on Perry Field in recent years.
