ANN ARBOR, Mich., May 22.—Chicago University High outclassed the field in Michigan Interscholastic meet Saturday on Ferry Field, piling up 26 points to 14 for Kalamazoo and Cass City who were tied for second.

As a result of its victory the Chicago school takes permanently the Sid Millard cup, offered to the school winning it three times, and the Huston Bros. cup, for winning the half-mile relay thrice.

A. Jones, of University High School, was also individual point winner with 15 points. He won both hurdles, second in the broad jump, and third in the 100-yard dash. To round out his day he ran on the winning relay team.

Helme, of Lafayette, Buffalo, gave the best individual performance of the day by breaking the meet mark in the mile. This lad, who is senior two-mile champion, made the mile in 4:33 4-5, four seconds faster than the mark made in 1916 by Heupel, of Toledo Scott. Helme is training for the Olympic tryouts.

Miller, of West Waterloo, Iowa, won both dashes easily, although Jones, of Detroit Central, rushed him for awhile in the "220." This boy is said to be one of the best high school athletes seen on Ferry Field in recent years.

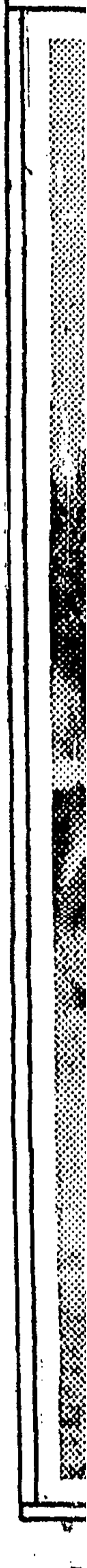
