

KAZOO NORMAL TAKE CINDER PATH MEETS

EAST LANSING, Mich., May 29.—
(By A. P.)—Detroit Northwestern high school won the M. A. C. state interscholastic track and field championship here today by a narrow margin over Grand Rapids Central.

Western State normal easily led the field in the intercollegiate meet with a safe 17 points over her nearest competitor.

Ideal track weather favored the meet and several M. A. C. interscholastic and intercollegiate records were broken. Noisch, of Detroit Eastern, set a new high jump mark by clearing the bar at 5 feet, 10 inches. In the intercollegiate running broad jump Allenberg of Kalamazoo normal cleared the old mark by one foot and six inches.
