

# COLTS CAPTURE TRACK HONORS

## Show Nicely Balanced Team Which Is Clearly Class of Meet.

Presenting a well rounded team which was able to place in every event, Northwestern High took the annual interscholastic track meet at the Armory Saturday evening.

Several "dark horses" came through in the events. In the first event to be run off, the 30-yard dash, an outsider broke the tape in advance of his field, Litvenberger, of Western, beating out Ozias, Highland Park; Hester, Northern, and Blauman, Northwestern. Hester and Blauman were picked to fight it out for first place.

Kline, of Cass Tech., ran a pretty race in the mile, leading from the sixth lap to the fourteenth, two from the finish. Here the Mechanic runner "blew" and permitted Brinker, Eastern, and Breton, Northwestern, to pass him. He might still have placed, but he slowed up entirely and the field passed him.

### RECORD HOLDER WINS.

Stuart, of Eastern, who broke the city record for the shot-put in a recent dual meet, won his favorite event with a heave of 43 feet 1 1/2 inches.

Hendrian, Northwestern, beat out Brinker, Eastern, in the half-mile event. The Indian was picked to win, as he has shown great form in this race, and also in the mile, this season.

Eastern went out of the running for first place when it failed to place in either the 220-yard dash or the 30-yard high hurdles. Northwestern took first place in both events, also placing second and third in the furlong, and third in the hurdles. Until these events were reached the Indians and the Colts were on an even basis.
