**High School Lads Victors in  
D. A. A. Indoor Track  
Meet at Y. M. C. A.**

High school athletes literally ran outcasts from clubs off their feet in the invitational mile event at the D. A. A. track meet in the Y. M. C. A. gymnasium last night and took all three places.
