

# High School Track Men Hold Meet at M. A. C.

## Wealth of Material for Track Squad Seen in Competition in Inter-class Meet at Michigan Aggie; Tishrock Wins Closely Contested Mile Run.

Track athletes from Lansing high competed in an inter-class track meet on the Michigan Aggie cinder path Tuesday afternoon. Because of the difficulty connected with classifying some of the competitors as to classes, total results were not available at the close of the meet.

In the half-mile relay, the team representing the juniors edged out opposing quartets and won by a narrow margin at the close. During the course of the run which was negotiated in 1:44:1, the seniors and juniors switched leads twice, the winners going to the front for the last time within 50 yards of the finish.

Among the events for individuals, the mile-run was the most closely contested. Tishrock who won the event in 5:27:3 took the lead at the beginning and set the pace for the entire four laps. Gallbraith and Monroe attempting to close in on him during the last hundred yards crossed the line almost neck and neck, and not more than five or six feet behind the winner.

The final heat of the 100-yard dash was another hard-fought event. To take the first place, Fitzpatrick stepped around Clevenger just before he broke the tape, and Alderman, third-place winner, was tight on the heels of

the leading pair as they crossed the line.

A large number of high school students attended the meet, and the keen competition kept their attention well-centered throughout the long program of events.
