

LOCALS DEFEAT CROSWELL HIGH IN TRACK MEET

Coach Lake's Boys Score 65 Points Vs. 39: "By" Philp Leads In Honors

Port Huron high carried away the honors of its dual field meet with Croswell high school at Driving Park, Wednesday afternoon garnering a total of 65 points to 39 scored by the visiting track delegation. No records were threatened in the event though the meet proved a very successful one.

The 880-yard run resulting in a tie for first place honors between Baker of the local school and Middleton of Croswell, both runners holding up to the finishing wire neck and neck, featured the entire program. Points for first and second in the event were divided accordingly.

Points winning the relay number Port Huron took first place in six events, the 25, 100 and 200 yard dashes, the running and standing broad jump and the pole vault, while the visitors captured first place honors in four affairs.

There were in the shot-put, high jump, 440-yards and the mile run. "By" Philp topped individual honors of the afternoon for Port Huron, scoring 18 points. He finished first in the 220-yard, 100-yard and 160-yard dashes and was second best in the shot-put. Middleton was the best performer for Croswell, coming under the top first in 2 events, the 440-yard and 880-yard runs.
