
SETRIGHT BREAKS STATE RECORD BUT IS DISQUALIFIED

Ray Setright, Jackson High athlete, Saturday afternoon lowered the state interscholastic record for the 100-yard dash to 10 2-5 seconds, making this mark in his trial heat, only to be disqualified for the final heat in the dash because he did not have his eligibility papers with him.

The state record for the 100-yard dash, set by Merchant in 1916, was 10 3-5, and that was the time in which the final of the dash was run yesterday.

The runner who finished second to Setright in his trial heat in the 100-yard afterward took first place in the 220 dash.
