

ANN ARBOR WINS CROSS COUNTRY

THE STATE INTERSCHOLASTIC
HARRIER RACE WON BY
LOW SCORE OF 27

Battle Creek High Was Third in
Points, Two Places Ahead
of Kalamazoo Team

Ypsilanti, Mich., Nov. 13. — (U. P.)—Ann Arbor won the first cross country run of the interscholastic championship here Saturday, when Hornberger, Scarlett, Konupek and Butler crossed the line second, third, fifth and sixth, respectively. Their score was 27.

Kutschinski, Grand Rapids entry, made the best time, running the distance in 13 minutes, 28 seconds, but the fifth man on the team failed to finish, thereby eliminating the Furniture City entry from first honors.

Other schools and their scores were: Northwestern, 96; Battle Creek, 101; Detroit Eastern, 103; Kalamazoo, 111, and Detroit Northeastern, 117.

The winner was awarded a gold medal, while others were given silver and bronze medals.
