

LOCAL HARRIER SQUAD MAY RUN

HIGH SCHOOL WILL SEND A
TEAM TO YPSI IF DATE
IS ACCEPTABLE

First Cross-Country Championship
Race for Michigan Prep.
Schools is Announced

The Battle Creek high school will enter a six-man team in the first state championship harrier meet at Ypsilanti this month, providing the date is set for either November 25 or 30, according to Track Coach John Sterling. Sterling sent word to Ypsi yesterday to this effect.

Plan Open Meet

Ypsilanti, Mich., Nov. 3. — (U. P.).—Coach L. W. Olds, of the Normal, announces the first championship high school cross-country run to be given in the state. This is not an invitation meet and all schools having a six man cross-country team are invited to enter them. Four of the Detroit high schools have been entered and it is expected that the other two will enter before Friday noon, November 10.

Ann Arbor and Kalamazoo have entered teams. It is expected that Grand Rapids schools will also be represented, as well as Battle Creek.
