A state championship indoor track meet and the second annual Michigan State championship basket ball tournament are among the early Spring activities planned by the Detroit Amateur Athletic Association.

The track meet will be held in April following the national interscholastic swimming meet in Chicago. The basket ball tourney gets under way the week of March 20 and ends April 1. The executive committee of the D.

A. A. A. at its meeting on Wednesday decided to hold an indoor track meet, probably at the Armory, to stir up interest in track and field events. The Central A. A. U. track and field meet will come to Detroit next Summer, having been awarded The Betroit News Athletic Association. It is to bring out athletes who might be good enough to take part in the Central events that the. indoor meet is being staged. LITTLE COMPETITION.

There has been little indoor track

competition in the city this Winter. Detroit has seen only the dual meets between high schools. The athletes competing for clubs or independently have had no competition. Last Winter there were half a dozen club meets staged at the T.

M. C. A., and at the high schools under the auspices of the D. A. A. A. As a result of these meets there was a great deal of interest in track and field athletics last Summer and meets were staged on Belle sle, at the Masonie Country Club, at the State Fair and other places. A team representing the city was sent to the Central meet at Chicago, the first track team to leave the city for track and field competition in more than a decade.
