

### COLTS STRONG IN TRACK MEET

**Northwestern Qualifies 19  
Men to Enter Finals on  
Saturday.**

Apparently injuries, ineligibility and illness do not hit the Northwestern high school track team as hard as they might because the Colts qualified 19 athletes in the trials held at Northwestern gymnasium Wednesday afternoon for the finals at the armory Saturday night.

Eastern, Central and Northern registered 17, 15 and 19 respectively. Cass Technical has eight, Western and Northwestern five each, and Southeastern one. Numbers usually mean strength when applied to the Colts and they are again favorites to win a third straight Greater Detroit indoor track title.

**Hurdles is one.**

Huntington, Eastern high jumper, did not appear for the trials because of illness which will also keep him out of the Saturday contest. As he was a certain point winner, the Indians are taking his absence with a grim face.

Failure to note he had another lap to go cost Miles Turpin, Northern, the chance to enter the finals. Miles thought he was through on his final tour and stopped running. He changed his mind after an interval but changed it too late. Harold Davis, Northwestern, will have little competition with both McCausland and Turpin absent. A. Sebald, Central, and Withins, Cass Technical, are the only leg boys who will push him. Sebald ran his first in 40 2-5. Davis made the same mark.

**No Records Made.**

No attempt was made in any trial or heat to establish any records, as qualification only was sought. Northwestern and Eastern made the same time in the relay and will run off the line in a Central Thursday afternoon.
