

SAGINAW TRACK BOYS DEFEATED

Highland Park Wins, 67-10, 220-Yard Event Is Dead Heat.

Highland Park High School defeated Saginaw Eastern 67-10 in a dual track meet Saturday at Highland Park.

Saginaw was completely outclassed taking but one first place, the shot put, which Smith of Saginaw Eastern threw a distance of 31 feet 1 inch.

Ozias and Thorp each took two first places, the former taking the 35-yard dash and tying for first in the 220, while the latter won the high jump and the pole vault.

Highland Park runners scored slams in the mile and half mile event. Courtney, who finished first in the mile, placed second to Hayes in the 880.

Robinson of Saginaw Eastern and Ozias of Highland Park featured the meet with a dead heat in the 220. The pair fought for the lead all the way and crossed the finish line together, the judges deciding that neither had an advantage and the points for first and second places were divided.

The shot put was the only event in which Saginaw athletes gained more than one place, Smith taking first place and Trauckner third. This event alone gave the Sawdust City lads more than half of their points.
