

PREPS GLITTER IN ISLE MEET

Seven City Interscholastic Records Fall in Triangular Contest; Eastern Victor.

Northwestern Loses First Outdoor Track Competition in Three Seasons.

Seven city records fractured, a state mark equaled and a few upset featured the triangular meet at Belle Isle yesterday afternoon, won by Eastern with Northwestern second and Ann Arbor third. The Indians scored an unexpected victory, with 41 points, while the Colts scored 37 and Ann Arbor, 23. Northwestern was the favorite to win by a comfortable margin, but for the first time in three seasons, the tag and fray was set back in an outdoor meet.

Hamiltons Go High

Hamiltons, Eastern, beat his own city record of 5 feet and 2 inches by adding one and one-half inches to his previous mark. The pole vaulter from Macauley, the team's first, took the lead in the final jump, with the Detroit team taking the trophy. Detroit's record was 4 feet 10 inches.

An upset came in the quarter-mile, when captain Marshall, Macauley, took the lead in the final lap and failed to place after a great start, while Marshall, Eastern, took the lead. The two girls were almost out of control, the junior girls' team was carried in 2:15, which bettered the city record.

Simpson in Form

Full Simpson, Northwestern, almost equaled the city record of 117 yards in the 100-yard dash. He topped the 117-yard mark by 12 feet, 12 inches, and won the race in 1:12. Simpson, who showed in the indoor meet was a disappointment, but he showed his speed in the 100-yard dash.
