

## LANSING WINS TRACK EVENTS

**Murray and Beal Make Only  
First Places for Battle  
Creek—Field Soggy.**

The Battle Creek high school track team was decisively beaten by the Lansing high school yesterday afternoon in the first dual track meet of the season. The final score was 83 to 40. The local team was outclassed in nearly every event and in no event did Battle Creek take all three places.

Murray and Beal took the only first places made by the high school, Murray taking first in the mile as usual and Beal winning first place in the low hurdles by the close margin of one-fifth second. The meet was a slow one all the way through due to the condition of the local track and also that the competition was not great enough to warrant the exertion to the utmost, which is necessary when records are made.

Aldeman of Lansing made the most in individual points in the meet, taking first in the 100-yard dash, first in the 220-yard dash, and first in the running broad jump.

The results of the meet follow:

Fourty yard.—Cannon, Lansing, first; Beal, Battle Creek, second; Loneyear, Lansing, third. Time, 17 seconds.

Shot put.—Noble, Lansing, first; Walker, Battle Creek, second; Baird, Lansing, second; Tichroek, Lansing, third.

Twenty dash.—Aldeman, Lansing, first; Schout, Lansing, second; Hicks, Lansing, third. Time, 24 seconds.

Eighty yard.—Dickson, Lansing, first; Watrous, Battle Creek, second; Scanlan, Battle Creek, third. Time, 2 minutes, 17 seconds.

Running high jump.—Esoughton, Lansing, first; Schaar, Lansing, second; Drews and Fobes, each of Battle Creek, tied for third place. Height, 5 feet.

Twenty yard low hurdles.—Beal, Battle Creek, first; Loneyear, Lansing, second; Tichroek, Lansing, third. Time, 29.5 seconds.

Running broad jump.—Aldeman, Lansing, first; Noble, Lansing, second; Walker, Battle Creek, third. Distance, 29 feet 6 inches.

Pole vault.—Lansing, all three places.

Relay.—Lansing relay team. Time, 2 minutes 27 seconds.
