

### Big Red Athletes Qualify • in Four Events at Michigan

ANN ARBOR, May 27.—Lansing high qualified in four events for the final of the Michigan interscholastic field and track meet in the preliminary held yesterday afternoon. Detroit schools carried off the majority of the honors, Detroit Eastern and Northwestern each qualifying seven men while Detroit Northern and Highland Park each qualified six, followed by Saginaw Eastern with five and Detroit Central, Lansing and Allegan with four.

Algerman of Lansing qualified for both the ten and 220 yard dashes, Cannon in the 100 and 200 yard dash, and Bouck in the high jump. Detroit Eastern who entered the distance in 34 seconds. Bouck was third high in the high jump which went at five feet six inches in the trials and was won by Lester of Detroit Central.
