

RECORD BEATEN IN BROAD JUMP

Don Cooper Stars in D. A. A. A. Handicap Track and Field Meet.

In the second meet of the year held under the auspices of the Detroit Amateur Athletic association fairly fast times and distances were recorded and in the majority of events competition was keen. Due to it being a handicap affair no points were awarded.

Don Cooper was the star individual performer of the meet, breaking the state record in the standing broad jump with a leap of 10 feet 1 3/4 inches; winning the 30-yard low hurdles in 4 2-5 seconds, and tying for first in the 30-yard dash. With the 32-inch handicap allowed him in the broad jump added to his actual jump, Cooper's handicap jump record was 12 feet 9 3/4 inches. This is over a foot farther than the existing world's record.

Northwestern high school, the Y. M. O., and Detroit Junior college were the only organized teams entered in the meet. The rest of the contestants were either unattached or only one member of a team was present.

Northwestern presented the best balanced team, entries from that school placing in the 30-yard dash, the low hurdles, shot put, the 220-yard dash and their medley relay team won that event in 8 minutes and 40 seconds. Mills and McKenna, of the Y. M. O., staged a neck and neck race in the 220-yard dash, the latter defeating his team mate by a scant yard.
