

HESTER PARES WORLD'S MARK

Northern Star Wins 50-Yard Dash, Reduces Record by Tenth of Second.

Northwestern Gets Second Place in Swimming Meet; 5 Points for Northern.

Evanston, Ill., March 24.—"Buck" Hester, Detroit Northern, hung up a new world's record in the 50-yard dash at the Northwestern interscholastic track and field meet here this afternoon, negotiating the 50 yards in 23.10 seconds, one-tenth of a second better than the old time.

Gene Goodwillie, of University high school, Chicago, forced the Detroit lad to the new record, there being only a bare yard between them at the tape.

Oak Park annexed first place with 111.2 points, Evanston taking second with 18.

University high school of Chicago was third with 11, Cedar Rapids (Iowa) fourth with 11. Northwestern and Central of Detroit each secured six points and tied for fifth with La Salle, Ill. Northern, Detroit, got bye and Eastern, from the same city, four.

Through the efforts of Eddie Flannagan, Northwestern finished second to New Trier in the swimming meet held in connection with the track contest. The Colts got 18 points to New Trier's 26. Flannagan won both the 40 and 100 yard swim. Northwestern also won the medley relay. Jeffries of Northern won second in the backstroke and third in the 40 yard event.
