

HURON SCHOOLS IN COUNTY MEET

Seven Schools Guests In Bad Axe Friday

Bad Axe, May 28—Seven high schools have entered squads in the Huron county annual field day meet to be held here Friday. Eleven events for boys and five for girls are scheduled.

Schools represented by teams will be Harbor Beach, Sebawaing, Bad Axe, Pigeon, Ubyly, Port Austin, Elkton and possibly Caseville. Not all of these schools will send girl track teams but all must be represented by boys on the cinder track. This will probably be the largest since the first field day in the spring of 1920.

The schedule of events outlined by the committee, E. J. Johnson, Harbor Beach, A. L. Olney, Ubyly and A. G. Saddler, Pigeon, are: For boys, 100-yard dash, 220-yard dash, 440-yard, half-mile run, mile run, standing broad jump, running broad jump, running high jump, 12 pound shot put, pole vault and half-mile relay.

The events for girls include: Fifty yard dash, 200-yard relay, shot put, basketball throw, and baseball throw. The officials of the meet are L. C. Wendt, starter, and A. A. Jones, head timer.
