COLDWATER WINS AT EAST LANSING

Takes Class B Interscholastic; Plainwell, Class C.

East Lansing, Mich., June 2.—Coldwater, in class B, and Plainwell, in class C, were winners in the first section of the seventeenth annual Michigan Intercollegiate track and field meet, held on the Michigan Aggie field today.

Class A schools will compete for the state championship in the second section of the meet Friday and Saturday of next week.

For Plainwell it was a third successive victory. Allegan, winner in class B the past two years, was relegated to second place, as Coldwater came up strong in the field events to make a total of 30 1-2 points. Allegan had 21 1-2 points, while Petoskey, third in class B, had 18 points.

Plainwell amassed 48 points, to win easily, taking places in every event but one. Morenci, second in the class, had 20 points, while Cass City, third, had 17. Twenty-five of the 29 schools competing scored points.

George, of Petoskey, proved the individual star, scoring 17 of the 18 points with which Petoskey was credited. George took firsts in the high hurdles and pole vault, seconds in the low hurdles and high jump and fourth in the broad jump.

No meet records were threatened during the competition, most of the established times and marks being held by class A athletes.
