

# Big Red Track Athletes Win Saginaw Valley Meet

## Minus Services of Stars, Lansing Tracksters Fight Gamely All the Way to Final Triumph—Napier Upsets Dope by Hurling Javelin Beyond All Previous Marks.

By scoring 43 1-2 points, Lansing high track team added more laurels by copping the Saginaw Valley track and field meet, held on the Alumni field at Saginaw, Saturday. Saginaw Eastern and Lansing fought for the lead throughout the entire meet, and not until the final event was the victor known. Saginaw Eastern finished with a total of 41 1-4 points, while Arthur Hill high placed third with 34. The remainder of the points were distributed between Owosso, Bay City and St. Louis.

Although the locals were minus the services of Noble, Longyear and Henson, they managed to squeeze through with just the required number of points to win. Every man taken on the trip scored at least a few points.

### Napier Wins Javelin.

The greatest upset in the meet, was the fact that Napier of Lansing won the javelin throw, with a heave of 153 feet 10 inches, a new Valley record. Lovette of Arthur Hill is considered the best man in the state at this event, but nevertheless he was unable to come up to Napier's mark. Until the two final events Lansing had but an outside chance to win the meet, but when Napier came through with a first in the javelin, and the relay team won an unexpected first, Lansing forged into a slight lead.

Three records were broken; Lovette of Saginaw Arthur Hill tossed the shot 44 ft. 11 inches, while Napier easily copped the javelin by throwing the stick 158 ft. 10 inches.

Lansing athletes won 5 first places, out of the 13 events. Oade won the discus. Napier the javelin,

Tischrock the high hurdles, Schaar the low hurdles. The relay team, composed of Tischrock, Oade, Kingseott and Schaar, easily won this event.
