

HESTER MAKES DASH RECORD

**Detroit High Schools Lead in
Number of Athletes Placed
at M. A. C.**

**Northern Runner Sprints 100
Yards in 9 8-10 Seconds
for New Mark.**

East Lansing, June 8.—Running under almost perfect conditions, except temperature, George Hester, the stocky little captain of Detroit Northern, ran the 100-yard dash in 9 8-10 seconds here today in the preliminary trials of the state high school meet, setting a new Michigan interscholastic record and placing himself in the select list of runners bettering 10 seconds for the distance. The mark displaces the record made nine years ago by Henry, of Detroit Eastern.

Realizing that it was the opportunity he had been waiting for, the little Detroit dash gave everything he had in his heat. He led his field by more than 10 yards at the tape and the three watches all recorded the same time, equal to the 99 4-5 seconds record of the days before the tenth second watch came into vogue.

He was content with this effort, and in the preliminaries and semi-finals of the furlong contented himself with placing only.

Detroit schools led in the number of men placed, with Lansing and Jackson making the best showing of the outside schools. Jackson placed Otto in both sprints.

Fields were so large that preliminaries and semi-finals were necessary in the high hurdles and the 220-yard dash and preliminaries in the quarter mile when 20 runners answered the call.
