60 yard high hurdles—Won by Cuhel, Cedar Rapids; Royer, Oak Park, Ill., second; Spence, Detroit Western, third; Walworth, Oak Park, Ill., fourth. Time, :08. [Ties Northwestern interscholastic record made by Butler of Rock Island in 1915.]

Running high jump—Won by Gandenski, Lane, Chicago, height 5 feet 10 inches. Betting, Lake View, Chicago; Bartlett, Lyons, and Friberg, Lane, tied for second, height 5 feet 9 inches.
