

### CROSWELL WINS TRACK CARNIVAL, DIAMOND CROWN

Gilbert Is High Scorer of Annual Meet With 21 Points

Sandusky, June 7.—Crowell won the annual Sanilac county track and field meet here Friday for the second straight time and today needs only one more leg on the annual cup to gain permanent possession of it. The Crowell athletes, led by Gilbert, who counted 21 points, scored 56 points, more than double the total of their nearest rivals, Brown City, who counted 23 points, due to the prowess of Bubly. Bubly accounted for 13 points, winning three firsts in the dashes and one second.

Crowell took the lead at the start of the meet. Until the last event had been run off they were well out in front without a rival worthy of taking their measure. The Crowell school sent one of the best balanced aggregations to the meet that has ever represented them.

Sandusky finished in a tie with Deckerville for third place with 14 1-2 points, while Mariette had one point. Leanington scored only one point.

Two meet records were broken. Wood, Sandusky athlete, broke the javelin record when he heaved the spear 141 feet. The former record was 119 feet, held by Cline of Crowell. The other record to fall was in the 120 yard low hurdles. Powell, Crowell, equalized the distance in 18 seconds flat, beat the former record by three-fifths of a second.

In the girls' events, Crowell again took first place, making it a clean sweep in the track events. The Crowell lassies counted 15 points. Brown City finished in second place with 10 points, Deckerville was third with seven, while Sandusky had 3 1-2 and Mariette one-half of a point.
