

LOWELL HIGH WINS KENT TRACK MEET

Rockford Is Second; Also Cops County Ball Title By Beating Grandville.

TWO RECORDS SMASHED

Lowell, June 9.—Lowell high school with 56 points easily won the track championship and Rockford rallied in the ninth inning and beat Grandville for the baseball title at the annual Kent county interscholastic athletic association field day held here Saturday. Rockford with 27 1-3 points and Sparta with 16, trailed Lowell in the track and field events.

Two county records were shattered. Flogaus of Lowell pole vaulting 10 feet and 6 inches, four inches higher than the record established by Wheeler of Cedar Springs, in 1916. Peterson of Rockford tossed the discus 104 feet and 6 1-8 inches bettering the record of 102 feet and 1 inch made by Rice of Cedar Springs in 1918. Schwab of Lowell equaled the 220-yard dash record time of 21 2-5 seconds.

The result of the track meet never was in doubt as Lowell took places in every event counting with eight first places, four seconds and four thirds. Other schools besides the three leaders to take points were: Cedar Springs, 6 1-3; East Grand Rapids, 4; Grandville, 3 5-6; Caledonia, 3 5-6.

Grandville Blows Up.

Grandville took an early lead in the baseball game, but blew up in the first of the ninth when Rockford base runners proceeded to maneuver at will. The score was 6 to 4 at the beginning of the frame, but before it had ended Rockford was one run in the lead. Grandville rallied in their half, but were beaten with a man on third. Jewell pitched a creditable game for the winners striking out eight batters and keeping 10 hits well scattered. Van Leeuwen performed well on the mound for Grandville letting the winners down with nine hits.
