

NORTHWESTERN WINS CONTEST

State Interscholastic Track Meet Goes to Detroit School—Smith Wins Jump.

Lansing, June 7.—Northwestern of Detroit needed third place in the relay, the last event on the program of the 18th annual class A interscholastic track championship meet held on college fields here Saturday morning, to return home victorious.

And the Colts, for good measure, proceeded to take first and make the victory theirs beyond all doubt. This success made the Red and Gray total 32 points. Kalamazoo Central had 24 1/2 and Lansing 19 1/2, for second and third places, respectively.

Western, Detroit, Muskegon and Northern, Detroit, each made 10. Eastern, Detroit, got eight; Battle Creek and Kalamazoo Normal high school seven each; Ann Arbor 6, Cass 5 1/2; Grand Rapids South 4; Detroit Central 3; Saginaw Eastern 2; Flint 1 1/2.

Kalamazoo could have gained the laurels by a first in the team race but the celery city boys found the race too wearing and did not connect.
