East Lausing, June 7,-in a track and field meet in which a half dozen records were smashed. Detroit Northwestern today won the state Class A high school championship by amassing 33 points.

The records to fall follow: 220 yard low hurdlers, 120 yard high hurdles, 880 yard run, running broad jump, 440 yard dash and discus.
