

SIX RECORDS GO AS DETROIT COPS SCHOOL HONORS

Northwestern Wins Track Meet Easily—Flint Barely Gets in Standings.

East Lansing, June 7.—In a track and field meet in which a half dozen records were smashed, Detroit Northwestern today won the state Class A high school championship by amassing 33 points.

Kalamazoo Central finished second with 24, Lansing took third with 19½ and three schools, Muskegon, Detroit Western and Detroit Northern, tied for fourth with 10 points apiece.

The records to fall follow: 220 yard low hurdles, 120 yard high hurdles, 880 yard run, running broad jump, 440 yard dash and discus.

Spence, of Detroit Northwestern, broke both hurdle records. He went the 220 low in 24.6 seconds and the 120 high in 16 fl.

Oosterbaan, of Muskegon, tossed the discus 122 feet, 3¼ inches for a new mark.

Dauchert, of Detroit Northern, went the quarter mile in 51.2 seconds, setting a new record.

Smith, of Battle Creek, topped the previous best mark in the broad jump with 22 feet, 6½ inches.

The old half mile mark was shattered by Peegar, Detroit Northwestern, who stepped the distance in two minutes, 2.9 seconds.

Other schools finished as follows: Detroit Eastern 8, Battle Creek 7, Kalamazoo Normal high 7, Ann Arbor 6, Detroit Cass Tech 5½, Grand Rapids South 5, Detroit Central 4, Saginaw Eastern 3, Flint Central 1½.
