

CASS, CENTRAL WIN ON TRACK

Mechanics Set New Mark in Relay in Defeating Northern, 64 to 31.

Trailblazers Prove Too Powerful for Falcons and Score Easy Victory 63-31.

Central and Cass Tech scored easy victories in their dual track meets with Northeastern and Northern, respectively, Friday afternoon, Cass winning from the Falcons 64 to 31, while the Falcons did the Central, 42 to 31.

The Mechanics, with Bill Loving and others in the major races, scored seven firsts and a like number of second places to take a lead over Northern that proved too much to overcome. The Cass avenue team made a clean sweep of the relay dash, high jump, shot put and 250-yard run aside from taking the relay in record time to pile up its margin.

In defeating Northeastern, Central annexed first place in six events and easily won the relay. The Falcons, however, in winning four first places, made their best showing of the season.

Events of Central and Lewis of Northeastern, each winning honors in scores. Nonschick, however, produced the best individual feat of the meet in leaping 19 feet 4 inches in the pole vault.

The Cass Tech team lapped the field in obtaining the city record, giving the gladiators in 1:12 2/3 seconds. Gates, the anchor runner, was out to a good lead in the last lap and won with many yards to spare.
