

NILES FIRST, ST. JOSEPH IN SECOND PLACE

Benton Harbor Finishes in Third Place; Good Marks Are Recorded

Niles, St. Joseph and Benton Harbor finished first, second and third respectively, in the annual field and track meet of the "Little Ten" conference last Saturday afternoon on Wells field.

The scores of the nine schools competing in the meet, which was marred somewhat by a heavy rain that temporarily halted the proceedings, follow:

Niles, 21½; St. Joseph, 21; Benton Harbor, 19½; Allegan, 19¼; South Haven, 18; Otsego, 14; Plainwell, 14; Dowagiac, 7; Three Oaks, 5.

Shafter's best records were set in the 100-yard dash, which shattered in the event, an exceptional performance in view of the weather conditions and the slow track. They were:

100-yard dash, which Kessler of Benton Harbor stepped in 10.9.

Half mile, which Burns of Niles completed in 2 minutes and 8.42 seconds.

120-yard high hurdles, which were won by Miller of Otsego in 37.4.

220-yard low hurdles, which Hall of Niles covered in 23.3.

Pole vault, in which Capt. Helden of St. Joseph cleared the bar at 11 feet 3 inches. It was one of the afternoon's outstanding performances.

Javelin throw, in which Hisscock of Allegan tossed up a mark of 147 feet 3½ inches.

Shot jump, in which Thomas of St. Joseph registered 23 feet 9½ inches.
