

### THREE SCHOOLS POINT TO FIRST MEET ON TRACK

Cass, Southwestern and Northwestern Officially Open Outdoor Season on Saturday.

#### COLTS LOOM STRONGEST

Red and Gray Boasts Veteran Squad For Triangular Test on Prospectors' Field.

Northwestern, Cass Tech and Southwestern, three of the strongest teams in intercollegiate track, officially will open the outdoor track season with a triangular meet at Southwestern field Saturday afternoon.

The competition is the lone test scheduled by prep officials before the fifth annual city championship meet, and will serve as a preparatory test for the title affair.

Each school boasts a veteran squad and although Northwestern, last year's champion, is favored to finish honors, it will have the slightest chance of opposition in winning from the two other entries.

The Colts have a well balanced combination being equally strong in the field events and dashes while Cass says most strong on the dashes and the Prospectors in the long tests.

#### Colts Add Strength

The Northwestern school has taken honors in both indoor and outdoor track during the last two years and on this showing has visions of going through the present season without a defeat. While the veterans are expected to carry most of the burden, several new comers have shown marked ability in practice and may give the Colts even more strength than was expected.

"Duke" Rose, who confined most of his activities to the gymnasium, has developed into a sprinter that gives promise of extending any ability in the city. He has given Jimmie Tall, city champion, a close run for honors, beating him to the line in the century on several occasions. On this showing the Colts have visions of again annexing the sprint honors in every event.

Not alone are the sprinters strong, but with Jimmie getting close to record distance with the javelin, considerable strength has been added in the field tests. Aside from the javelin, Jimmie is equally adept at the hurdles. Carlsson is depended upon in the hammer and discus throws and Cross and Angerville will carry the task in the long runs.

#### Cass Shows Improvement

Cass probably has shown the greatest improvement and is looked upon as a serious menace to the Colts' chances of retaining the title. In Bill Loving, Glenn Cunningham and Toles, the Mechanics have a quartet that can not be surprised for all around ability and the points gathered by this combination will make competition interesting for any opponent.

Southwestern, while not considered as strong as the other, boasts several stars that will keep the Prospectors well on the potential. Earl Ingham holds the pole vault title and seems to be alone in this respect. Aside from him, Baker and Holcomb are strong competitors in the field. Sheridan and Russell are depended upon in the quarter mile while Vlachietz is the main cog in the sprinters.

This triangular test will enable followers of track competition to judge the probable contenders for the city honors in the meet that follows one week later.
