Team Strength Counted.
Team strength saved Northwestern, in every event but three the Colts taller and while they amassed but pure first places, they came when needed most and turned victory into Northwestern's hands when Case Tech's chances looked very good.

The other schools were out of the running almost from the first event. Coldwater took third place with a 1-2 point, Northwestern and Lansing tied for fourth with a 11 and the best showing the Falcons ever have made in the state meet. Kalamazoo Central 7 1-2, Ann Arbor 7, Southwestern 5 1-2 were the schools next in order after Coldwater.

Case Always Dangerous.
Case first abounded and then secured Northwestern's edge. Egan, Egan and Tech 16 points by winning both the 100 and 220-yard dashes. Loving added two more firsts in the hurdles and tie for first in the high jump and for 15 1-2 points. His individual high total of the meet, had Case the secondary split winners, as did Northwestern, would have been an 18.
