

Detroit Boys Star in Junior Olympic

Four Detroit boys won places in the National Junior Olympic in which thousands of boys throughout the United States took part as part of the Boys' Week programme, according to the report of the Junior Olympic Committee just released.

James Childs was second in the baseball distance throw with a record of 247 feet and second in the 60-meter dash which he made in 8 1-5 seconds.

His record in the latter event was shared with two other boys who made it in the same time.

James Russell shared his second place in the 70-meter dash made in 8 4-5 seconds with a boy in Cambridge, Mass. James McCracken took second in the running broad jump with a distance of 18 feet. First place in that event went to a boy in Brigham City, Utah, who jumped 18 feet 9 1/2 inches.

Ed Tolan placed third along with four other boys in different cities in the 100-meter dash. The time was 11 2-5 seconds.
