

**TRACK HONORS
WON BY COLTS**

**Northwestern Scores Heavily
In Field Events to Win
Triangular Test.**

Northwestern high school, showing superior strength in the field events, overcame the four point margin gained by Cass Tech in the first day of the triangular meet at Southwestern field and easily annexed the honors with 58 points. The Mechanics finished with 42, a margin of 17 points ahead of Southwestern.

Despite the one-sided victory of the Colts, Cass carried off honors by bettering two city marks and equalling a third in the events Friday afternoon.

Eddie Tolan, after a poor start, tied the mark in the century by breaking the tape in 10 1-5 seconds and later bettered record time when he negotiated the 220 yard stretch in 23 1-10 seconds. The other mark to be bettered was the half mile which La Fleur turned, in 2:05 3-10 seconds.
