

# Order Track Athletes Capture State Honors

## Pick Up 65 Points in Michigan A. A. U. Championship Meet, a Total Which Puts Them Ahead of Urban A. C. and Millett Club.

Though held more or less even on the track by the Urban and Millett clubs, Young Men's Order predominated to such an extent in the field events that they again carried off the honors in the Michigan A. A. U. championships, held Saturday, under the auspices of the Irish-American Athletic club on Belle Isle.

Urban A. C. which has in its ranks a number of prominent high school performers, displaced the Millett club as the nearest rivals of the Y. M. O. The total of points was: Y. M. O., 65½; Urban A. C., 46, Millett A. C., 46½; Gas House Gang, 18, and Detroit Y. M. C. A., 8.

With 154 athletes representing 358 entries, the meeting was a record one. A large crowd was present throughout and the contests proved to be of exceptional interest.

### Tolan Heads Sprinters.

Eddie Tolan, Urban A. C., was the pick of the sprinters, doing the 100 yards in 16 1-10 seconds, cutting 2-10 seconds off last year's record, and the 220 yards in 22 3-5 seconds. Lewis, of the same club, was second in the 100, and third in the 220, being beaten for second place by Strong of Y. M. O.

Y. M. O. got in the 440 with Bentley and first and second in the 880 with Phillips and Don Seeger. The mile went to a newcomer, R. H. Callahan, who is not yet attached to a club. His time was seven seconds behind the record.

### White, Minnick, Finish Strong.

An extraordinary strong finish was seen in the five mile-race when Millett's Indian runner, Chauncy White, repeated previous victories, by nosing out Saylor Minnick, of the same club, on the flat. White and Minnick ran practically shoulder to shoulder throughout the distance, leaving the rest of the field far away.

Bill Lovins, Urban A. C., captured the hurdle races over the 100 and 220-yard distances. His opposition came from the Gas House Gang, Leland getting second and third places respectively, while Coplan was second in the 120.

Alexander Plutynski won the three-mile walk with ease. He outdistanced his two opponents, both of whom were disqualified for running.

### Allman Stars in Weights.

D. I. Allman, unattached, gave a great exhibition in the weights, carrying off the prizes for the 16-pound shot put, discus throw, hammer throw, and the 56-pound weight. Wolf, of Y. M. O., came
