6 MARKS FALL AS Y. M. O. WINS

Urban A. C. Second and Millett Third in Belle Isle Meet.

Six new meet records were established in the second annual Michigan A. A. U. track and field championships staged on Belle Isle Saturday, by the Irish-American A. C. The meet was won for the second time by the Young Men's Order with a total score of 65½ points to 46 for the Urban A. C., the runnerup. The Millett A. C. was third with 40½, Gas House Gang fourth with 18 and Y. M. C. A. with 3.

The high lights of the game were the new marks in 100-yard dash, the half-mile run, the relay, the javelin throw, the hop, step and jump, and the hammer throw.

NEGRO BREAKS FIRST.

Eddie Tolan, running for the Urban A. C., a Negro athletic club, set the first record of the meet, a mark of 10 1-10, for the 100-yard dash, two-fifths of a second faster than Bernard Otto's time last year.

This was followed by a 1:59 1-5 half-mile by Hector Phillips, 37-year-old runner of the Y. M. O., by a 3:37 2-5-mile relay by the Y. M. O., a toss of 165 feet 4½ inches by Otto E. Spanenberg in the javelin, a throw of 131 feet 3 inches in the hammer throw by Dell Allman and a leap of 43 feet 5½ inches by Eugene Ryan, of the Y. M. O., in the hop, step and jump.

HIGHT-POINT MAN.

Dell I. Allman, an unattached athlete, was the high point scorer of the meet with firsts in the shot put, the hammer throw, the 56-pound weight and the discus throw, for a total of 20 points.
