

# ANOTHER WIN FOR CASS

Cass Tech won its second dual track meet yesterday when it routed Western 56 to 39 in the Mechanics' gym.

Beauvais furnished a double upset when the Cowboy flash defeated Bill Loving in the low hurdles and usurped the Mechanic's position as high point winner in this meet. Beauvais won 16 against Loving's 14½ points to rank as the star of the fracas.

Western showed unexpected strength in all events and with a leader like Beauvais may be counted on to make considerable trouble in the championship meet. Cass Tech won seven firsts as against its opponent's four but were not able to tally in many subordinate positions.

The Mechanics' relay team which holds the city record, although minus several of its stars, managed by splendid passing to lap the Cowboy quartette and come within two seconds of equaling the record for that size track. Alexander, although not pressed, put the shot 41 feet 5 inches. Swzeed, in his debut as a miler, showed to advantage against his opponents.
