

**TRACK MARKS FALL
AS COLTS BEAT CASS**

R Northwestern Athletes Better
Times in Relay and
Quarter Mile.

Cass Tech's string of consecutive track victories ended Thursday afternoon when the Mechanics bowed to Northwestern, 56 to 39.

In recording the triumph the Colt athletes took six first places, in two of which the city records were bettered. Mosser was the first to better a former mark when he ran the quarter mile in 56 4-5 seconds. The former mark was four-fifths of a second slower.

The other mark fell when the Northwestern relay team of Ross, Seeman, Swan and Dant, clipped two-fifths of a second from the relay record of 1:31.

Cass held the lead until the third event, Eddie Tolan showing his heels to "Snitz" Ross in the 30-yard dash, and his brother took down first honors in the half-mile. But after these events Northwestern took a lead that was increased as the meet progressed.
