Looks for Second Victory Saturday Over Saginaw in Clash Here.

Successful in their last two meets, Flint Central high tracksters will try for victory over Saginaw Eastern thincads here Saturday afternoon. The meet will be held in the local gym and the time is set for 4 o'clock. Saginaw was defeated by the locals in a dual meet held there Jan. 23.

The Saginaw boys gave the Red-Blacks a lot of trouble in the previous meet. Crego, their captain, is star at the high jump, hop-step-jump and the shot put. He won three firsts for the upstaters in these events. Diamond, a dash man, is another comer although he did not get a first in these events, he made the local runners work.

Craig, of Flint, has not been given the credit due him this season because of the outstanding things that Harrell has done. Craig is a veteran member of the team and is a consistent point getter. The 440 and the relay are the events in which he shines. Last week he smashed the local gym record in the former event and did a lot to put the relay team in the lead.
