

THREE RECORDS ARE SHATTERED BY SCHOOL BOYS

Detroiters Win Michigan Track Honors—Flint Gets in Two Events.

Ann Arbor, March 20.—(AP)—Detroit Northwestern topped a strong field of high school track teams here tonight to win the second annual state invitational indoor meet. Three records were smashed.—The half-mile run, 50-yard dash and pole vault,—and time throughout the meet was generally fast. Northwestern scored 21 points, 3 1-2 ahead of Kalamazoo Central, with Cass Tech of Detroit third, 15 1-2, and Detroit northern, fourth, 11.

Burson, of Waite high school, Toledo, outran Teeters, of Elkhart, Ind., for a record of 2:06.1 in the 880-yard run. H. Tolan, of Cass Tech, held the lead until the last 200 yards, but Burson's reserve carried him past both Tolan and Teeters.

The third event on the program, the 50-yard dash, saw the second record smashed, when G. Simpson, of East Columbus, Ohio, ran away from Ross, of Northwestern, to set a new mark. Ross, who only last year established the previous record, could not keep up Simpson's clip.

Detroit Northern, represented by March, took the pole vault with a mark of 11 feet, 6 inches, a record.

Seven of 11 point-bearing events saw Northwestern's colors placed in the first four. Following the leaders in point scoring came Flint Central, 5; Waite, Toledo, 6; Gary, Ind., 1; Ann Arbor 2; East High Columbus, 5; Elkhart, 6; Highland Park, 6; Thornton High, Harvey, Ill., 5; Detroit Northeastern, 5; Saginaw, Arthur Hill 5; Detroit Western 1, Libby, Toledo, 3; and Glenville, Cleveland 3.
