

Benton Harbor Beats St. Joe In Hard Fought Dual Meet On Filstrup Field Saturday

Second In Broad Jump By Black Gives Orange A Two Point Margin For 62 to 60 Victory Over Sister City Thincclads

Running a neck and neck race throughout the afternoon Saturday, Benton Harbor's track team finally defeated St. Joseph 62 to 60 points at Filstrup field in the annual dual meet for the twin city schools.

Some surprise placings in the field events gave Benton Harbor the slight edge by which she defeated St. Joseph. Benton Harbor won first in five events, and St. Joseph took nine events.

Black and Taylor were the outstanding stars for Benton Harbor, with Norberg carrying the brunt of the St. Joseph attack. Only a small crowd witnessed the contest which was close and exciting to the last minute.

Finish is Close

The outcome of the meet practically hinged on the broad jump as that event was called. Benton Harbor led by a 47 to 59 point margin, with the broad jump, and relay—both conceded St. Joseph events, still to be run.

Sims quickly stepped out in the broad jump as the first place man, and a battle for second followed. On the last leap of his last trial, Black passed the 39 foot mark, for second place in the broad jump, and victory in the meet. St. Joseph won 13 points in the two final events, but the three taken by Black gave Benton Harbor the 62 point total.

The javelin throw, was called off before it was completed because of a broken javelin. The high jump was conceded, and not completed because of a lack in time. Norberg took the pole vault at 19 feet, and was hardly pushed. He therefore did not break his own 11 ft. 2 1/2 ft. record.

Taylor surprised the field Saturday by his splendid sprint efforts. He conditioned his team mate, Jacobs in the century and 220 yard dashes, and placed second to Norberg in the 220 low hurdles, running three splendid races.

Black Leads Scorers

Jacobs was off color. Ralph Black came to the rescue in several bad holes, with his usual first in the high jump, a second in the broad jump, a second in the discus, and a third in the javelin.
