

# TWO CLUBS TIE FOR TOP PLACE

## Young Men's Order and Old-Timers Score Equal Points in Track Meet.

Young Men's Order and Old Timers' Athletic Club tied for team honors in the Michigan A. A. U. track and field meet on Belle Isle Monday. Each scored 54 points.

Up until the final event, the javelin throw had been completed, the Order, the defending titleholder, held a slender lead over the remainder of the field. The Old Timers scored a first and a fourth in the javelin throw, while the Y. M. O. failed to place. This gave the former a tie for the honors.

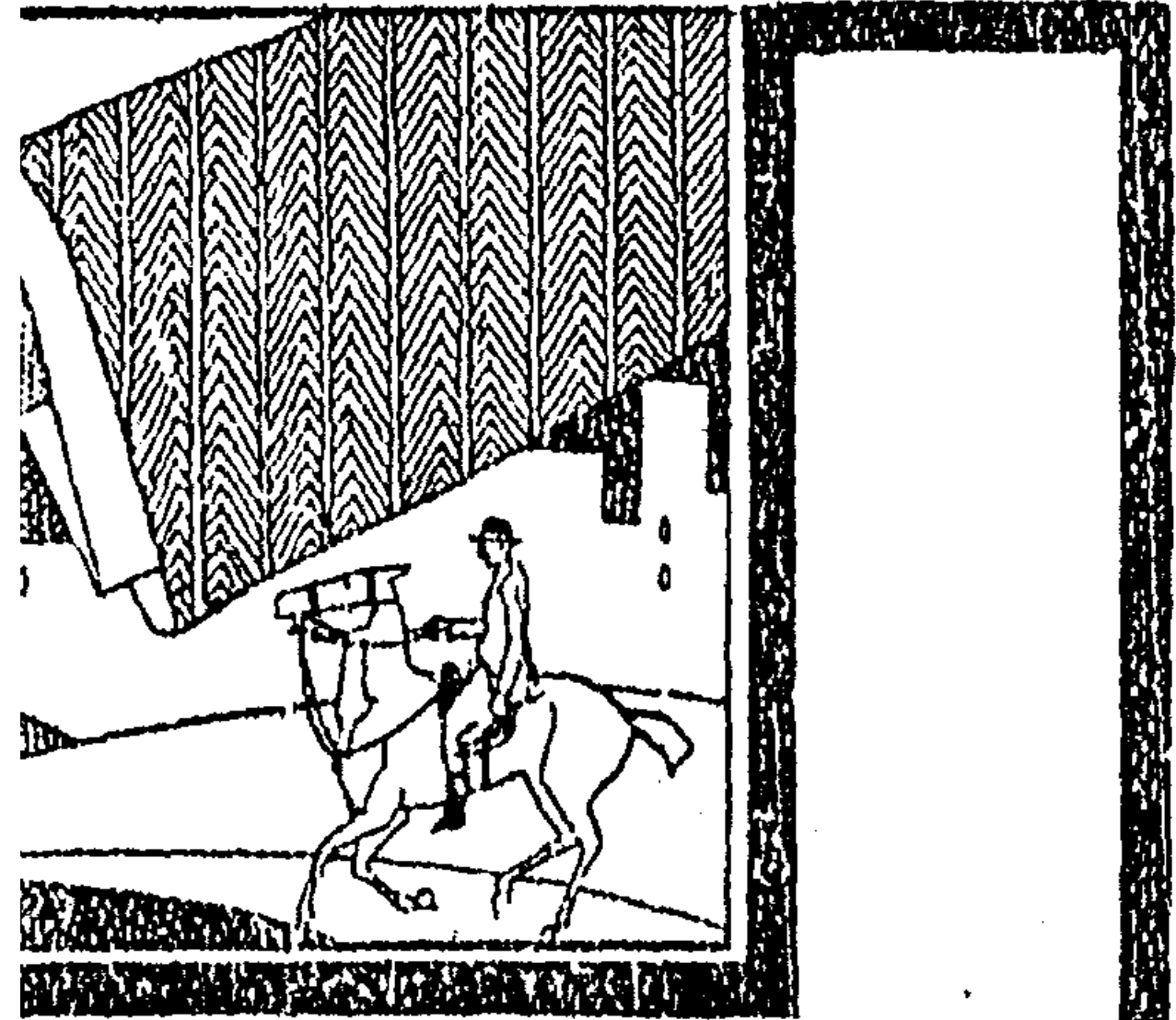
Detroit Athletic Association was the runnerup with 41 points. Other organizations which got into the scoring column were Detroit Track and Field Club, Detroit Y. M. C. A., Ypsilanti Normal, Danish American A. C. and the Polish Falcons.

New meet records were established by Harry Hawkins of the University of Michigan in the hammer throw. Del Allman of the Y. M. O., in the discus throw and Edward Spence of the Old Timers in the low hurdles. Marks were equalled in the 56-pound weight, the 440-yard dash and the pole vault.

Kenneth Doherty of the Old Timers was the high point scorer of the meet with first in the javelin throw and running hop, step and jump, seconds in the high hurdles and the shot-put and a third in the discus throw for a total of 18 points. Allman of the Y. M. O. was first in the shot-put, discus throw and 56-pound weight.
