## Wins Eight Out of a Possible 10 First Places.

Capturing eight first places out of a possible 10, Northeastern High School opened its 1927 indoor track season Tuesday with a victory over The Southeastern, 60-35. Falcon thirda'ds placed in every event and scored a "slam" in the 25-yard dash.

Ecknovich of Northeastern set an unofficial record for the mile run in 3-5. Eugene Beatty, 1:48 with three firsts, a tie for first, and a second to his credit, was the high scorer of the meet.
