



## Girls' Track

THE girls' track team consisted almost entirely of new athletes this season. It made a good showing in the city meet, as well as taking three dual meets in which they participated. The two schools it defeated were Highland Park and Southwestern, the latter winning the city track meet; Western lost to Northern. In the city meet, held May 25, Western placed third. Edith Harwood, a tenth grade student, broke the city record for the running broad jump; she bettered the old mark

by a foot and three and one-half inches. Merilda Dei, captain of the team, took third place in the city meet in the high jump. Violet Bartha won second in the 75-yard dash; the relay team came in third.
