ANN ARBOR, Mich., March 19—(AP)—Athletes of the Oak Park Illinois High School won the third annual Michigan interscholastic meet here tonight with 22½ points. Detroit Northeastern and Detroit Northwestern, favorite to repeat its victory of last year, tied for second. Froebel school of Gary, Ind., took fourth by winning the final event, the pole vault.

The winning team made an excellent showing in the track events, winning the half mile and the mile relay and getting six points out of the 440 and the mile run.

No unusual records were made.
