

# SCHOOL STARS ENTER NATIONAL CONTESTS

## Twenty-Five Will Compete in Northwestern Meet.

Twenty-five Detroit High School athletes, 14 for track and 11 for swimming, will compete in the national interscholastic championships at Northwestern University at Evanston, Ill., March 25 and 26.

Northwestern High, winner of the city championships in both track and swimming, has the most representatives on the team with nine swimmers and seven track men. Cass Tech and Northeastern each have two boys on the track team while Western High has three. Northern and Highland Park each have a place on the tank squad.

Last year Cass Tech won the national track honors while Northwestern placed second in the swimming.
