

# TWO DETROIT PREP STARS IN TITLE RACE

## Tolan and Beatty Survive for 50-Yard Finals.

EVANSTON, Ill., March 26.—Detroit high schools will have two men among the four athletes who toe the mark this afternoon at Patten Gymnasium here to determine the interscholastic 50-yard dash championship.

They are Tolan, of Cass Tech, and Betty, of Northeastern. They won their way to the finals yesterday afternoon over a field of more than 70 contenders.

Beatty, who showed early class in the high hurdles, was unable to qualify among the six that will contest for that title today. Beauvals, another Detroit high school athlete, was the only one of that city's athletes to make the grade in the hurdles competition.
