

West Side Girls Dethrone Southeastern as City Track Champions.

Southwestern high school girls broke the two year reign of Southeastern as city track champions yesterday at Codd field by winning the annual city track meet.

It was the relay event that decided the meet as Southeastern, defending champion, was leading when the final event was called. The Jungaleers, however, could not match the speed of the west side contingent and this setback lost the meet and title by a margin of one point. The new champions garnered 15 points in which two new records were established.

Southeastern pulled up in second place with 14, while Western landed third with 11. The other schools were far outclassed and finished in this order: Northeastern 8, Cass 5, Highland Park 5, Northern 5, Strathmoor 5, Commerce 3, Redford 1.

Edith Harwood of Western accounted for the first new record when she registered a leap of 15 feet, 5 inches in the broad jump and Mary Tilson, of Northeastern, furnished the other in the high jump when she cleared the bar at 4 feet, 6 3/4 inches.

Because of a high wind that blew over the hurdles the timber topping event was postponed until next week.
