

COLTS TOP FIELD IN QUALIFYING AT SCHOLASTIC MEET

Northwestern Places 12 Men —Campbell Runs "100" in 10 Second Flat.

East Lansing, May 28.—(AP)—Michigan's high school athletics met here today to decide, in competition, the crowning of the state's individual and team track and field champions.

Every indication, early today, was that the laurel wreath would rest tonight on few of the brows it decorated for the past years.

Cass Technical high school of Detroit, team champions for the last year, qualified few men in the preliminaries yesterday and was not considered as one of the three high teams. Detroit Northwestern, qualifying 12; Detroit Northeastern with its stars entrenched in six places and Kalamazoo with its strength in the distance runs, all were doped to be higher than the last year's champions, when all the events had been finished tonight.

In classes B and C, also the last year winners failed to impress in the preliminaries yesterday. St. Johns qualified one athlete as the representative of the last year's class B champions, while Otsego, the class C leaders, failed to qualify one. A new class D also is awaiting a new leader with the end of today's trials.

Not more than four individual winners will hold their last year's laurels. Tolan, Cass Tech., winner of the two dashes last year, won his way into the finals again, while Bator, Detroit Southeastern, winner of the javelin a year ago, qualified in that event yesterday.

Of all the class B and C leaders, Dirkse, Grand Haven, winner of the discus throw in 1926, is the only one that qualified again yesterday.
