

## KALAMAZOO CENTRAL TAKES NORMAL MEET

**Celery City Team Wins  
Twelfth Annual Track Event  
With 44½ Points.**

Kalamazoo, Mich., May 7.— Ten records were broken and another tied here today as 800 high school stars of Michigan took part in Western State Normal's twelfth annual interscholastic.

More than 60 schools were represented in classes A, B, C and D, and athletes of 59 different high schools figured in the point winning.

Kalamazoo central's well balanced team won the class A school trophy, running away from Grand Rapids south in the late events to pile up 44½ points. Grand Rapids was second with 27 1-3 while Benton Harbor and Holland trailed with 17 and 15 points, respectively. Black of Benton Harbor was the high point man, winning the javelin and high jump and placing third in the discus. Fenker, Kalamazoo's fleet dash star won both short dashes, doing the 100 in 10 and 3-10 and the 220 in 22.6, tying his own record made last year.

Dowagiac won the class B championship, taking the half mile relay, the final event, in a battle with Three Rivers.

Farrish of Dowagiac was high point man, winning the low hurdles and placing in the high hurdles and shot put.

Rock Fleming, Plainwell high school coach, brought a team that ran away with the class C honors, scoring a total of 33 and 2-3 points. Otsego was second with 17 and 1-9 and Eaton Rapids third, with 15. Two athletes came to the meet from Woodland and took the class D title from a large entry. Hawkins won 15 of Woodland's 29 points and his partner, Hynes, had but one less.

Centreville trailed with 27 points.
